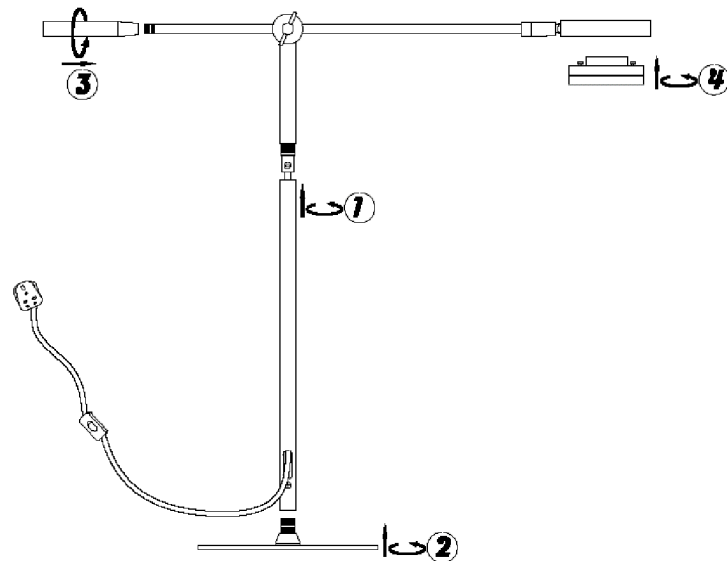

SALIX TABLE LAMP

Thank you for purchasing your SALIX TABLE LAMP and we hope it will bring you many years of service. Please read and retain the following important instructions.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Be careful when unpacking the lamp since the wires are connected.
If the wires are pulled out of their connectors, it may result in a bad connection.

1. Remove all components from the carton.
2. Fit top lamp section onto tube by holding lamp holder section still and turning the tube (1)
3. Place the lamp base upright on a flat surface and carefully locate assembled tubes onto the treaded section and rotate the base (2) until the assembly is hand tight.
4. Carefully feed the cable through the grommet in the side of the bottom tube until the excess cable has been all fed through taking note to remove the twist in the cable as you go. NOTE do not over tension or pull the cable.
5. Fit the counterbalance weight onto the end of the lamp holder arm (3).
6. Fit the recommended Westlite GX53 LED lamp into the socket (4). Lamp rating is 1 x up to 11w GX53 LED lamp.
7. Remove card wiring instructions from the plug face and making sure the power is off plug into the mains.
8. Switch on and off at the in-line switch. Always switch the lamp off before removing the plug from the mains socket.
9. Keep the lamp clean by dusting with a dry cloth, do not use any type of metal cleaner as this will affect the clear lacquer finish.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

If you are in any doubt consult a person competent to give advice on the assembly of electrical equipment.

Always be sure to use the correct type and wattage of bulb as indicated on the fitting.
If the external flexible cable of the lamp is damaged it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
When changing the bulb, always unplug from the mains and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of used bulb carefully.

This product is fitted with a 3amp safety fuse.
